LENTEN WORKSHOP

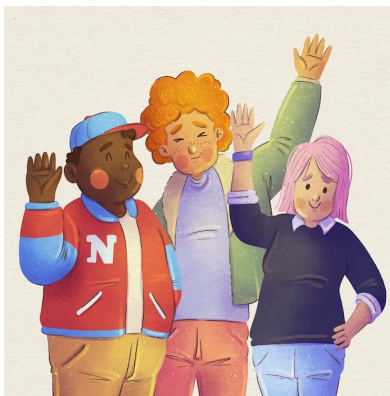
On Sunday, March 2, we will be hosting Lenten Workshop in Chalice Hall following the second service. This is an annual event when children, youth, and adults gather to kick
